












AfDB-GEF Portfolio by country



- GEF implementing agency since 2007
- AfDB's GEF portfolio has grown tenfold over the past 6 years and now includes 41 projects in 33 countries for a total \$356 million in GEF grants (CCM, CCA, BD, LD, IW, CW and MFA)
- Access to GEFTF (STAR Allocation), LDCF, SCCF and others (IW, SFM, ...)
- Big potential of project origination with ADF and ADB window
- Dedicated Unit for GEF origination and implementation follow-up
- Project aligned with National priorities (CSP and NSP)

Objective: To promote circular economy approaches within national development frameworks to achieve economic development while scaling-up BAT/BEP to mitigate POPs/Mercury pollution

TA COMPONENT 1

Strengthening the enabling environment and national enforcement capacities for the management and phase-out of POPs/Mercury and its compounds

Budget: 3 M USD

TA COMPONENT 2

Communicating the environmentally sound management of chemicals and wastes

Budget: 3 M USD

INV COMPONENT 3

Scaling up of actions to reduce and wherever possible, eliminate manufacture, trade, use, emission and release of POPs and mercury and its compounds

Budget: 12 M USD

TA COMPONENT 4

Monitoring and evaluation, learning and adaptive feedback

Budget: 2.3 M USD
